An understanding of the issues surrounding wild salmon and sea trout is essential, and a familiarity of aquaculture and other sectors affecting fish and fish habitats would be an advantage.

AFT is looking for an individual with a degree in a scientific or environmental discipline who has practical experience working in the field. The successful candidate for the post will be enthusiastic, aspires to develop, is self-motivated, and able to work well within a small team.

Ideally the applicant should also be qualified to SFCC team leader standards in electro fishing and have experience with GIS mapping program. A full driving licence and familiarity with GIS mapping software is essential.
